Day 1: Arrival in Sri Lanka – Transfer to Waikkala (approximately 45 minutes) 20 April 2026

Day 2: Negombo to Sigiriya (approximately 3.5 hours) 21 April 2026

After breakfast, meet our guide at 8am at the Hotel Lobby and set off on a scenic journey to Sigiriya, located in the heart of the Sri Lanka Cultural Triangle. En route, we'll take you to a restaurant in Dambulla for lunch, and while lunch *isn't* included, you'll enjoy a host of Sri Lankan delicacies from the restaurant's a la carte menu. After lunch, we'll continue our journey to Sigiriya. Upon arrival, check in to the resort and unwind amidst serene natural surroundings.

Afternoon – Exclusive Minneriya Jeep Safari

At approximately 2:45pm, embark on an exclusive private jeep safari through Minneriya National Park, one of Sri Lanka's premier wildlife destinations. The park is most famous for its spectacular elephant gathering. This incredible sight is regarded as one of the largest gatherings of Asian elephants in the world. Day 3: Explore Rock Fortress, Village Life & Ancient Capital Exploration 22 April 2026

Get a great night's sleep because Day 3 starts early with a 5:30am ascent of Sigiriya Rock, often hailed as the "Eighth Wonder of the World." This 5th-century UNESCO World Heritage Site, also known as Lion Rock, rises majestically from the plains and was once the fortress-palace of King Kasyapa. Marvel at the ingenious engineering moats, ramparts, the grand lion-paw entrance, and explore the frescoes believed to reflect the ancient Gupta style. Don't miss the Mirror Wall, still etched with poetic graffiti written by visitors over a thousand years ago. At the summit, you'll be rewarded with breathtaking panoramic views and a powerful sense of Sri Lanka's royal legacy. After our hike, return to the hotel for a relaxing breakfast and refresh.

Late Morning – Hiriwadunna Village Trek & Traditional Sri Lankan Experience

Discover the rhythms of authentic village life with the Hiriwadunna Village Trek, a hands-on, culturally rich experience that supports the local community. Start with a bullock cart ride through picturesque paddy fields. Then, glide across Hiriwadunna Lake on a peaceful catamaran safari, soaking in views of traditional farmlands and village homes. Our morning ends with a home-cooked Sri Lankan lunch, served in rustic village style with an unforgettable taste of local hospitality.

Afternoon – Ancient City of Polonnaruwa Tour

Continue your cultural journey with a guided tour of Polonnaruwa, Sri Lanka's medieval capital and a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1982.

From 1017 to 1235 AD, this city flourished with royal palaces, Buddhist temples, and impressive

irrigation feats. Walk among the ruins of ancient structures, marvel at the stone carvings, and learn about the kingdom that followed the fall of Anuradhapura. The Gal Vihara statues, carved from solid granite, are a must-see highlight of this archaeological treasure trove. Return to the resort in the evening and relax after a day filled with history, heritage, and cultural immersion.

HIGHLY RECOMMENDED OPTIONAL TOUR: A guided bicycle tour, which includes bike and helmet, is available for \$5 USD cash and is an excellent way to explore the vast ruins at a relaxed pace.

Day 4: Sigiriya to Kandy – Caves, Culture, & Sacred Relics (approximately 3 hours) 23 April 2026

After breakfast, meet in the Hotel Lobby at 8am to set off on a scenic drive to Kandy, the cultural heart of Sri Lanka. En route, explore iconic heritage sites and local experiences that reflect the island's rich history and traditions:

Cave Temple – A Sacred Wonder

We'll start this day with a visit to the awe-inspiring Dambulla Cave Temple, a UNESCO World

Heritage Site dating back to the 1st century BC. This is the largest cave temple complex in Sri Lanka, with 2,000 m² of walls and ceilings adorned in intricate Buddhist murals. Inside, discover over 150 statues of the Buddha, including a magnificent 14-meter-long reclining Buddha carved directly into the rock. A truly spiritual and artistic marvel.

Spice Garden – Matale

Next, stop at a spice garden in Matale, where you'll gain insight into Sri Lanka's centuries-old spice trade. Learn how spices like cinnamon, nutmeg, pepper, and cardamom are grown, harvested, and processed, and discover their culinary and Ayurvedic applications. Stop for lunch at a local restaurant in Matale and enjoy some authentic Sri Lankan cuisine. Continue onward to Kandy, surrounded by misty hills and vibrant markets. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel and take some time to unwind.

Afternoon – Gem Museum, Temple & Scenic Views

In the afternoon, visit a Gem Museum, where you'll learn about Sri Lanka's world-famous

gemstones, including sapphires, rubies, and moonstones. Gain insight into traditional mining, cutting, and certification processes. Then, pay a visit to the sacred Temple of the Tooth Relic (Sri Dalada Maligawa), a UNESCO World Heritage Site that enshrines a revered relic of the Buddha. This temple is not only a spiritual center, but also a symbol of national pride.

Evening – Kandy City Walk & Cultural Dance Show

At 5pm, enjoy a leisurely walk around Kandy's lively city center, exploring colonial buildings, lakeside paths, and local shops. Then, experience the magic of a traditional cultural dance performance, featuring Kandyan drumming, fire dancing, and folk rituals that reflect Sri Lanka's vibrant artistic heritage. Return to the hotel and relax after a day filled with exploration and culture.
